MORNINGS: ACCESS TO THE SEMINAR PRESENTATION CLASSROOM



1. Cross the Sabatini Building straight to the end.
2. Go on diagonal to walk parallel to the red brick building (Betancourt Building). Enter the building through the last door. You should have the janitor point to your right.
3. Go up the stairs to the 1st floor.
4. Continue straight (towards a turbine seen at the end). Pass next to it and across the runway. Follow straight into the next building.
5. Take the stairs or lift to the 2nd floor.
6. Turn right and look for the classroom 7.2 J03

Any classroom is named as:

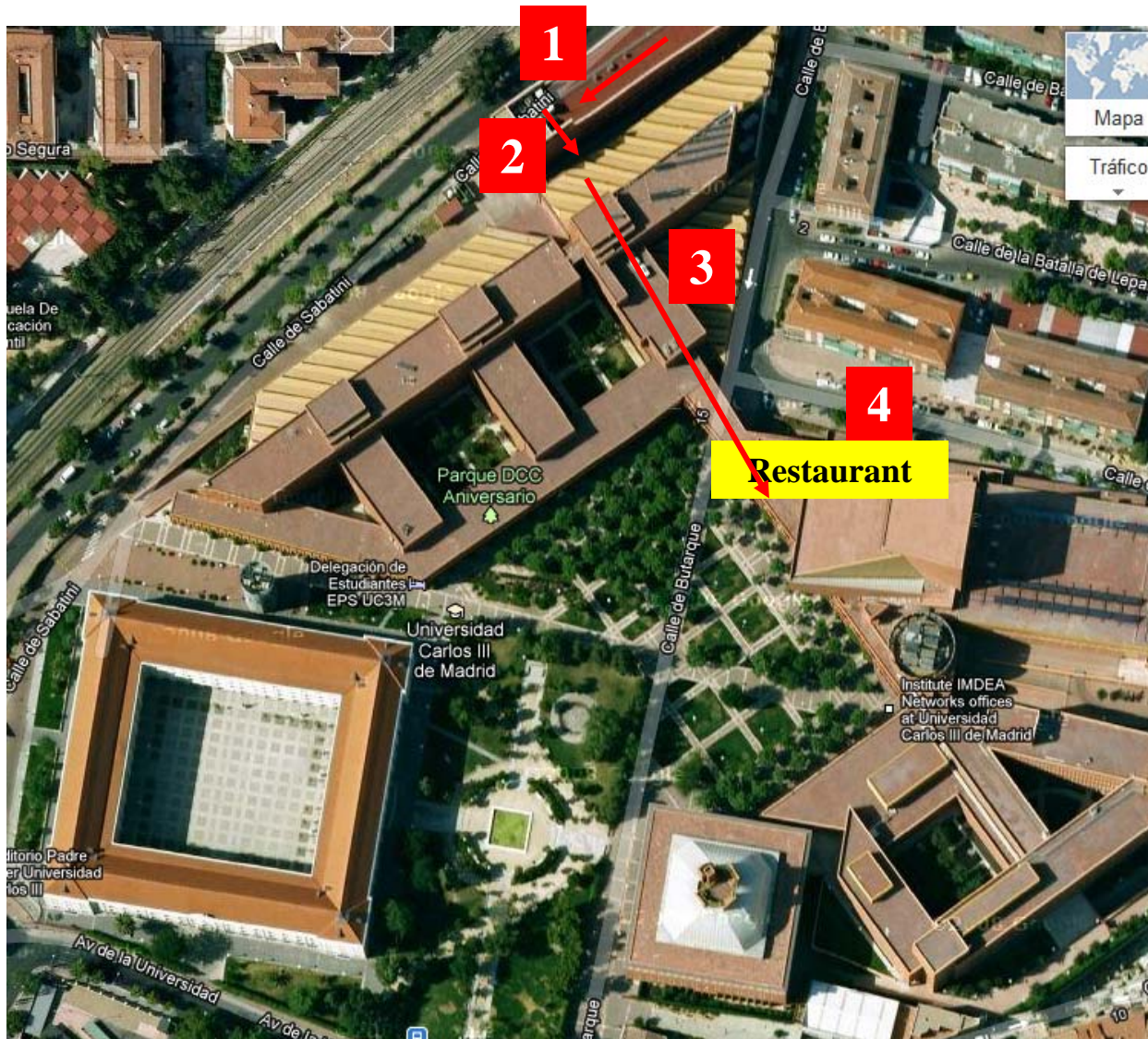
Building n°. Floor. Area. Classroom

Where Buildings n° to be used are:

- 1: Betancourt
- 2: Sabatini
- 7: Juan Benet

LUNCHTIME: ACCESS TO THE RESTAURANT



1. Leave the 7.2 J03 turning left.
2. Descend to the 1st floor.
3. Cross the runway into the other building, pass the turbine and continue straight to the very end. You should pass next to a sort of sculpture. Continue straight until you see a door, it is the restaurant.
4. Inside the restaurant turn left to take the self-service.

EVENINGS: ACCESS TO THE SEMINAR SIMULATION CLASSROOM



1. Leave the restaurant straight until you find the staircase to your left.
2. Go to the ground floor.
3. Leave the building.
4. Turn right and walk all the way back to the Sabatini Building.
5. There are lifts and stairs on each corner. Take one to the 2nd floor.
6. Turn right and look for classroom 2.2C05.

Note: Each side of the building has a different area letter. They are marked on the map in green.
